We are working with the students to be able to write responses to learning and reading, state a written opinion, or tell about something with details. The students should be able to write a sentence that begins with a capital, has spaces between words, and ends with a period. We also want to see that they are writing down a letter for each sound in unknown words and are using lowercase letters within words. If you notice that your student is putting capital letters inside of their words and sentences (unless it begins a name), please remind them that they should be lowercase. Keep up the good practice at home! ☺

You will find your student's penguin research in the folders today. They participated in teacher-led shared research to learn all about penguins. They loved it! Our lessons were completed both during reading and science time.

We completed Topic 6 in math about addition concepts. The students have done really well with identifying 2 groups and adding them up to find the sum. The tests were sent home today.
